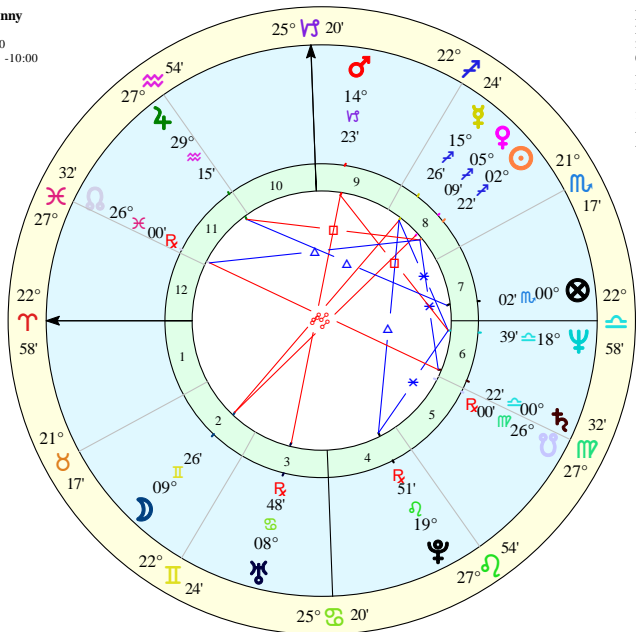

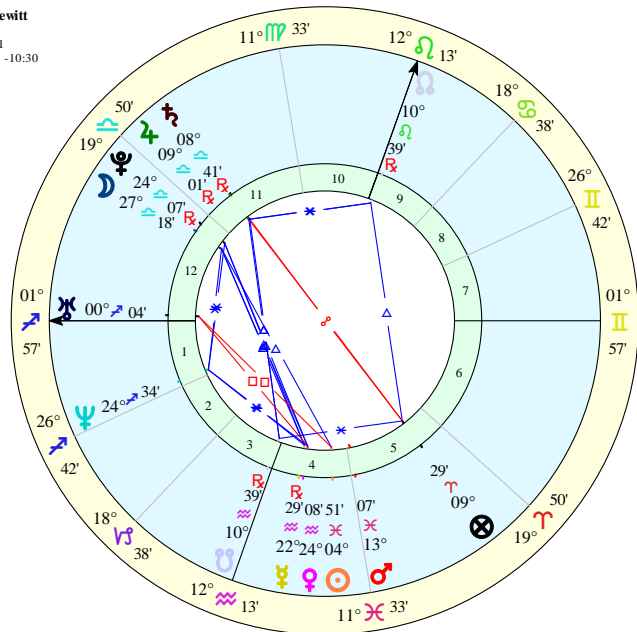

Introduction



This report has been written to introduce you to the concepts of astrology and how to get started in relationship astrology. Astrology is a complex and meaningful science which takes years to study and apply successfully; however, we would like to whet your appetite with this report, and encourage you to deepen your understanding through other means.

Astrology is a study of the connection between planets and life on Earth. It is based on a concept that energy patterns form between other planets and Earth and that these energies affect our lives as individuals and communities.

An astrological chart, also known as a horoscope, natal chart, or birth chart, records the relationship between the planets and the signs of the Zodiac. Charts can be calculated for the birth of a person, a community, an event or anything that seems momentous. The horoscope is as individual and unique as a fingerprint.

When using these interpretations, please bear in mind that, inevitably, every chart will contain some contradictory influences, and as a result certain interpretations of different items in the same chart may seem difficult to reconcile. However, this may still be an accurate reflection your chart, as it is likely that you do experience conflicting desires, events and circumstances in your life. Usually it is the responsibility of an astrologer to synthesise these apparent contradictions in order to present a cohesive and realistic interpretation of the dilemmas of the chart.

Please also be aware of the fact that each person has positive and negative influences in the chart, and therefore in their lives. The challenge is to accept and overcome the negative influences, so that we can successfully focus on the positive traits. This report outlines the influence of both people's charts on each other. This is called relationship synastry meaning the comparison of two horoscopes and the correlations discovered. It is likely that the report will show both the strengths and weaknesses of the relationship synastry. Any advice given is meant to be an aid to a person taking responsibility for their own lives and their own choices within a relationship. The ultimate decision rests with each individual. Individual Relating Traits



This section looks at each person's individual relationship concerns in their own personal birth chart. Every individual brings certain needs and expectations into a union, which affect his or her ability to feel loved and supported. This in turn affects the nature and course of the relationship.

Traits of Yvonne

Venus is in the 8th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the eighth house of your birth chart you demand a high level of commitment from both your personal and business partners. Some people might groan at the thought of entering a business partnership, risking their hard-earned money and having to rely on other people. Not you. Joint projects, in particular business ones, are a source of fulfillment. You're able to stay focused on the task ahead enjoying the challenge and the thought of the possible rich rewards. Depending on other influences in your birth chart, you're likely to benefit financially through joint projects, particularly business partnerships with your spouse. Sexual intimacy in marriage is important to you. It is a major source of enjoyment and self-expression within your most intimate union. For this reason you need to also be wary of becoming too possessive or jealous. As long as you choose someone who also expresses themselves well in a sexual union then your intimate life is rewarding. You're also likely to receive monetary gifts through some form of inheritance.

Venus is in Sagittarius

With Venus in the sign of Sagittarius you've a happy-go-lucky approach to your relationships, and yearn to share adventure with your partner, whether it be simply sharing adventurous ideas or taking off on a journey to another part of the world. Your motivation is to learn more about the world through your main relationships. In some cases your partner could be your teacher, perhaps even someone from a foreign country. You do enjoy relating to foreigners, because they can teach you so much about yourself and life in general. If you can't continually be on the road, then you like to hear about other people's journeys. Your friends come from all walks of life and you're popular, so there are many friends. You're benevolent and loving in all of your relationships, ready to join in on others' adventures and experiencing genuine pleasure in their company. Your generous nature means that you often encourage others in their journey through life. Your intentions are loyal, although you do sometimes have trouble sticking to your promises because the grass can appear so much greener in other parts of the world.

Venus is Opposite The Moon

You're likely to experience problems in your relationships, particularly your relationships with women. This

is because of the difficult combination of the Moon and the planet Venus in your chart. On the one hand you could tend to take your relationships for granted, spending little time or effort on improving yourself or your friendships. As a result you're likely to be somewhat unpopular and lose face. If you're looking for favours from your friends, or for a satisfactory primary relationship, then you need to take stock and improve your attitude. On the other hand it's also possible that your friends tend to take you for granted. On a more positive note you enjoy the company of other people, and may benefit through your relationships with women, but probably only with some effort on your behalf.

Traits of Lleyton

Venus is in the 4th House

When the planet Venus is placed in the fourth house of your birth chart relationships with your family are important. Your home and family are your refuge from the world. Whether you live on your own or with other members of your family, you like nothing better than to return home to a peaceful environment where you can relax and enjoy comfort and, if applicable, pleasant conversation. While some people might enjoy a boisterous household, you prefer a pleasant and harmonious environment. Your home is a showpiece, as you enjoy decorating and entertaining. Your garden, whether small or large, is also scenic. You like to have a sense of home and family, enjoying the company of your family members, particularly the women. Your life partner needs to respect this side of your nature, or better still, enjoy sharing the pleasures of your home and family.

Venus is in Aquarius

With Venus in the sign of Aquarius you're a social being by nature, enjoying friendships with people from all walks of life. This of course depends on other influences in your chart, which may indicate a preference for solitude. However, on the whole you're likely to flourish in groups of people because you make friends so easily. In other words you're a real party animal. You love to organise social events with your friends, and often receive invitations to various social events. You're the sort of person who talks to the person sitting next to you on the bus, easily striking up a conversation with a total stranger. Whether introverted or extraverted by nature you're particularly interested in sharing cultural and intellectual pursuits with your friends. It's important that you've the freedom to pursue your many friendships, and attend your group and social functions; otherwise you become restless and bored, and consequently rebellious. In fact you can also be quite stubborn, particularly in your intellectual views. At times you are given to excess, particularly in your younger days. For these reasons your primary partner in life needs to be someone who is intellectually stimulating and who understands your social butterfly urges, and is happy giving you plenty of room to spread your wings. You may find yourself attracted to unusual people, and possibly choose a partner, who's out of the ordinary.

Venus is Trine The Moon

You enjoy comfortable relationships with other people because of the favourable combination of the Moon and Venus in your birth chart. A charming and prudent person, you enjoy the company of other people, and they respond favourably. You're likely to enjoy success in your primary relationship, choosing someone who feels comfortable and companionable. You're also likely to benefit from your relationships with women.

Venus is Sextile Neptune

The planets Neptune and Venus are connected in your chart indicating that you yearn for romance in your primary relationship. Whether you realise it or not, you're seeking an ideal and perfect partner, who may only exist in fairy tales. If you're not careful you'll become disillusioned with the imperfections of relationships and seek solace in a fantasy world. You need to face the realities and imperfections of yourself and your partner as much as possible. This doesn't mean that you need to completely rule out romance and idyllic love. In fact it might help if you're able to escape with your loved one to a romantic setting, away from the demands of everyday life. Coming to terms with the reality of your relationship simply helps you obtain a better understanding of your primary relationship, and helps prevent you becoming disillusioned. In

other words taking off the rose-coloured glasses means that you can make a proper assessment of your primary relationship. Venus is Trine Pluto

In fact you prefer change, especially if the alternative is a staid and steady relationship. You like to be consumed with love and passion, and are happiest when with a partner who feels the same way. You can be disappointed when others fail to soar to great emotional heights and plummet the emotional depths by your side. You want intensity, perhaps even a little drama, in your primary relationship. You're fiercely loyal and committed, and expect as much from your partner. Problems can arise when you don't feel a strong bond with your partner, or if a third partner threatens your relationship. You're a jealous person, and quite capable of seeking revenge when wronged. You need to be careful to choose the right person as your primary partner - someone who reciprocates your love and passion. Venus is Square Uranus

The planets Venus and Uranus are combining unfavourably in your chart indicating that you're restless and often lack commitment in your personal relationships. This can lead to disappointments and complications in love and marriage, particularly in your early adult life. It's also possible that your roving eye can lead to scandal. You're willful and often perceive your primary partnership as demanding too much time and effort, an obstacle to your freedom of self-expression. You seek spontaneity and intellectual stimulation from your primary relationship. Unless other influences contradict this aspect of your birth chart, commitment is not a major part of your vocabulary, and can be something that you tend to avoid, preferring to be "footloose and fancy free". This isn't to say that you don't have many offers. Quite the contrary. Your bright and magnetic personality attracts potential life partners like moths to a flame, but you prefer to keep your options open rather than be pinned down. Depending on other aspects in your chart you may be satisfied with a gypsy-like approach to relationships. You may also like intrigue and secrecy in your relationships, perhaps even taking part in a secret organisation. Synastry Between Yvonne and LleytonPersonal Issues

This section looks at the interaction between two people and their two birth charts. It notes the nature of the relationship, whether it is likely to be a successful personal relationship or whether the forces at work are suggesting a less intimate bond. In other words how do these two people come together on a intimate level?

Yvonne's Moon is Square Lleyton's Sun (Orb 4°35')

'Opposites attract' could be the theme for this combination of personal planets. There is an instant spark when Yvonne and Lleyton meet, whether they choose to enjoy a friendship or a more intimate relationship. The world seems more exciting when they are together. When together Yvonne and Lleyton are able to broaden their horizons in ways they had not thought possible. Each one seems to fill a void deep inside the other. In astrology it is considered important to have a combination of personal planets in order to enjoy a deep relationship, but this can be a difficult combination once the initial excitement has worn off. Friction easily arises and what was once attractive becomes irritating. The success of this relationship largely depends on each person's ability to accept the other person's differences. Lleyton may eventually have difficulty understanding Yvonne's emotional nature. Lleyton may feel impatient and frustrated by the limitations placed on him by Yvonne. Yvonne may feel overwhelmed by Lleyton's personality. The initial excitement of the association with someone so opposing in nature may be replaced by feelings of insecurity. It's important for both Yvonne and Lleyton to continue to appreciate each other's differences at all times and to realise that this relationship is potentially very rewarding if the difficulties can be faced and resolutions found.

Yvonne's Moon is Square Lleyton's Mars (Orb 3°40')

In astrology Mars is the planet of drive and determination whereas the Moon is the planet of feelings. When these two planets form certain patterns the combination can be volatile. In this case there is a lot of friction in the relationship. Yvonne is likely to feel overpowered by Lleyton. Yvonne often wonders why she is so easily upset by Lleyton. No matter how hard she tries to calm her emotions Lleyton just seems to trigger heated feelings. Yvonne feels a strong attraction to Lleyton, but she is also aware that this is a troubled association. It is likely that Yvonne believes that Lleyton lacks sensitivity to her feelings. Lleyton also senses the friction, but is perhaps not so bothered by it. Lleyton is more concerned because at times Yvonne seems like a wet blanket. Lleyton's patience is tested because he feels that he has to console Yvonne's feelings before he can achieve his goals in life. Lleyton also feels a certain excitement in this association, but is aware that the tension can be an obstacle to fulfilment. If both Yvonne and Lleyton are aware of the problems and face them with honesty then an understanding can be reached and a rewarding relationship

result. When this occurs both Yvonne and Lleyton begin to feel that their lives have become more effervescent with the advent of this relationship. This combination is most difficult for a deeply personal relationship such as marriage or a close personal friendship. It can be advantageous for a working relationship that requires a lot of hard work and energy. For instance, building a house together may be a good way of using the energy of this combination.

Yvonne's Sun is Conjunct Lleyton's Ascendant (Orb 0°25')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Yvonne's Sun is combining with Lleyton's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant personal relationship. Yvonne and Lleyton feel strongly drawn to each other, experiencing a sense of completeness in each other's company. Yvonne can really shine through her association with Lleyton. She appreciates the benefits that this union brings into her life and the way in which Lleyton helps her achieve her personal goals. In turn Lleyton has a greater sense of well-being through his association with Yvonne. He welcomes the sunnier aspects of Yvonne's personality and appreciates their mutual respect and affection. While this combination is most likely to indicate an intimate love union, it can also augur well for friendships, family relationship and work associations.

Yvonne's Sun is Square Lleyton's Sun (Orb 2°28')

Any connection between two personal planets is considered auspicious in relationship astrology; however, difficult aspects can present a challenge. In this case the couple's Suns are making a difficult connection. On the one hand it is a positive sign that their Suns are connected. On the other hand Yvonne and Lleyton are presented with the challenge of overcoming some problems before experiencing the full rewards of this union. This is true whether they are forming a love relationship, friendship, family connection or working association. The major problem is one of rivalry. Yvonne and Lleyton experienced the instant attraction that comes with meeting someone different. They are poles apart in the way that they view the world. At first this seemed exciting, enticing and romantic. As times moves on, and the initial excitement wears off, they are presented with the obstacle of communicating with someone who views the world in a different manner. They are at cross-purposes and may resort to competing with each other, rather than co-operating. This can be frustrating, causing both Yvonne and Lleyton to sometimes feel as though they are 'hitting their heads against a brick wall,' as the saying goes. As long as there are other positive aspects in this relationship, both Yvonne and Lleyton are likely to overcome the obstacles and create a harmonious and loving relationship. However, they will both have to learn to 'walk a mile in someone else's moccasins'.

Lleyton's Sun is Square Yvonne's Venus (Orb 0°18')

This combination of the Sun and the personal planet Venus in relationship astrology is a difficult one. It indicates that the two people have conflicting values when it comes to personal relationships, which creates problems for any long-term association. Lleyton and Yvonne feel a strong attraction to each other, but they cannot seem to communicate in a harmonious manner. Joint decisions about relationships are difficult. Lleyton and Yvonne argue about subjects such as the future of their relationship, family associations, money matters and creative pastimes. They just can't seem to agree. Lleyton feels frustrated. On the one hand Lleyton is drawn to Yvonne. On the other hand Lleyton knows that he is losing his identity in this relationship, and is often floundering to express himself. Yvonne is also frustrated. She feels overwhelmed by Lleyton's powerful personality and is unable to get on with her creative pursuits. Neither Lleyton nor Yvonne really feels that they are benefiting from this union, and yet they feel drawn to try to resolve the problems. Depending on other connections in this relationship Lleyton and Yvonne may finally decide to end their association or they could resolve their differences. They may need to seek counsel on how to resolve their differences.

Lleyton's Mercury is Sextile Yvonne's Ascendant (Orb 0°29')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Lleyton's Mercury is combining with Yvonne's Ascendant indicating that communication plays a key role in this relationship. Whether it is a love union, a friendship, relative or work association, this partnership thrives on honest and open communication. Lleyton places more emphasis on

keeping spoken and written exchanges flowing. However, Yvonne also appreciates the manner in which this relationship enables her to share information and learn through interaction. This is a positive and lively relationship in which both Lleyton and Yvonne enjoy each other's company.

Yvonne's Mercury is Square Lleyton's Mars (Orb 2°19')

A feisty relationship is the result of this combination of the planets Mercury and Mars. When Yvonne and Lleyton are together the sparks fly. The nature of these sparks depends on other aspects of the relationship. On the one hand Yvonne and Lleyton may be positively stimulated by each other's company, enjoying lively conversations and energetic activities. This relationship brings a wealth of benefits for Yvonne. In turn Lleyton has a greater sense of well being through his association with Yvonne. He appreciates Yvonne's love of intimacy and her attitude to this union. Together they share a mutual respect and affection. While this combination is most likely to indicate an intimate love union, it can also augur well for friendships, family relationship and work associations.

Yvonne's Mars is Sextile Lleyton's Mars (Orb 1°16')

This is a feisty relationship full of healthy competition and possibly sexual frisson. In this association both Yvonne and Lleyton are challenged to produce their best efforts. They feel the sparks fly when they are together, bringing out an ambitious side to both their natures. As friends or work colleagues they enjoy the rivalry, and it is always possible that their shared drive and energy could become sexual, tipping their relationship into a love affair. Yvonne and Lleyton enjoy energetic activities such as sports and outdoor games. Together they feel able to conquer the world and overcome all obstacles in their path. Depending on other aspects of their relationship Yvonne and Lleyton may be lovers or friends, but this strong influence of the planet Mars can also indicate a work partnership that requires plenty of drive and initiative.

Primary Forces



In addition to the intimate aspect of a relationship, there are usually a number of fundamental driving forces, which can be either major challenges or inspirations to the individuals involved. This section looks at how Yvonne and Lleyton stimulate and provoke each other.

Yvonne's Moon is Trine Lleyton's Jupiter (Orb 0°25')

Lleyton feels that he is truly appreciated for his generosity and optimism. Together Yvonne and Lleyton can conquer the world. Nothing seems too far-fetched. This combination augurs well for a long lasting and happy relationship.

Yvonne's Moon is Trine Lleyton's Saturn (Orb 0°44')

A connection between the planet Saturn and the Moon is important. Saturn is the planet of commitment and stability and is often found in relationships that are long lasting. In other words a serious planet such as Saturn is needed for a serious, meaningful union. Yvonne and Lleyton are satisfied with the relationship and are willing to persist through troubled times realising that the rewards are great. A satisfying long-term relationship results from their patience and persistence. Together Yvonne and Lleyton are somewhat reserved, perhaps even withdrawing a little from society to enjoy the benefits of their relationship. They are aware that their relationship is one of the most important building blocks in their lives. There is maturity in this relationship. Perhaps Yvonne and Lleyton have formed this relationship later in life when they can truly appreciate each other and the life that they are building together. Yvonne feels that Lleyton is offering security and maturity, enabling her to mature in her emotional and home life. Lleyton grows in self-esteem through this relationship, believing that Yvonne respects his integrity. On the whole this is a positive combination for an enduring, long-term relationship such as marriage.

Yvonne's Moon is Sextile Lleyton's North Node (Orb 1°12')

Both the Moon and the Nodes individually are significant in relationship astrology. The combination of the Moon and the Nodes indicates that this is an important personal relationship, one that changes the course of Yvonne's life and deeply affects Lleyton. Yvonne and Lleyton feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. Whether the path of this relationship is smooth or rough, Yvonne and Lleyton's paths were meant to cross. The nature of this association depends largely on other aspects of Yvonne and Lleyton's charts. Passion may ignite if the right ingredients are involved, or friendship may be most appropriate choice of relationship.

Lleyton's Sun is Conjunct Yvonne's Jupiter (Orb 5°35')

The Sun and the favourable planet Jupiter are combining suggesting that this relationship is blessed with good fortune and happiness. It is an ideal combination for an intimate relationship such as marriage because it indicates shared philosophies on life and the ability to grow together. Together Lleyton and Yvonne land on their feet no matter how difficult a situation. They seem destined to be in the right place at the right time. Lleyton and Yvonne enjoy each other's company, feeling all of the benefits that come with this union. Their optimism and enthusiasm are infectious, and as a couple they are popular. In particular Lleyton shines as a result of his association with Yvonne. Lleyton feels able to embrace life and all it has to offer. He is aware that his union with Yvonne is truly blessed and that it helps him to achieve his full potential. Yvonne knows that her horizons are continually expanding through her association with Lleyton. Yvonne feels able to conquer the world. In fact it is likely that both Lleyton and Yvonne enjoy travelling, studying or teaching together. They enjoy sharing anything that expands their minds and contributes positively to their lives.

Yvonne's Sun is Conjunct Lleyton's Uranus (Orb 2°18')

This is a relationship full of verve and romance. Yvonne and Lleyton are attracted to each other from the moment that they first meet and continue to experience excitement and joy in each other's company. The relationship brings something new and original into Yvonne's and Lleyton's lives and they both feel enlivened as a result. Life becomes more of an adventure when Yvonne and Lleyton are together. Their relationship may run a somewhat erratic or unorthodox course, but Yvonne and Lleyton are both happy in the knowledge that theirs is a unique union. Yvonne is excited by Lleyton's creativity, which somehow enhances her personal goals. Lleyton helps Yvonne to see life in a new and different manner, freeing Yvonne from past inhibitions. Lleyton knows that he has encountered someone who truly appreciates him as an individual. Lleyton can better express his original thoughts and ideas as a result of his relationship with Yvonne. Together Yvonne and Lleyton may explore an unusual hobby or pastime such as new technology, metaphysics, science, electronics, humanitarian or environmental concerns.

Lleyton's Mercury is Conjunct Yvonne's Jupiter (Orb 6°46')

This is a positive combination of the planets Mercury and Jupiter and provides inspiration in any relationship whether it is a friendship, work association or more intimate union. Both Lleyton and Yvonne discover new worlds through their association. They enjoy broadening their minds through overseas travel or by learning about different cultures in books and study courses. Philosophy, metaphysics and religion are topics of conversation, which stimulate and expand their minds. It's also possible that Lleyton and Yvonne pursue activities connected with philanthropic or philosophical ideologies. In particular Lleyton's mind is extended through his relationship with Yvonne. Lleyton is willing to listen and accept the wisdom of Yvonne's ideas. In turn Lleyton is able to provide ways in which Yvonne can better communicate her ideas. Together they are able to grow and learn.

Lleyton's Mercury is Trine Yvonne's Neptune (Orb 3°50')

This is an inspirational relationship whether it be a romance, friendship or a creative working partnership. Both Lleyton and Yvonne feel excited by this union. Their imaginations are enlivened. In particular Lleyton's ideas are encouraged by Yvonne's creative input, enabling him to better express himself. It's possible that they work together on a creative project. Communication has an easy flow, more intuitive than concrete. Lleyton and Yvonne establish an empathetic bond which enables them both to exchange their thoughts and feelings with ease. If involved in a romantic liaison then Lleyton and Yvonne are likely to feel very much in love, viewing their union through rose-coloured glasses. Whatever the nature of the relationship, it is likely that Lleyton and Yvonne share an interest in the arts, a spiritual path or a philanthropic activity.

Lleyton's Mercury is Sextile Yvonne's Chiron (Orb 0°29')

Kind and gentle communication is an essential ingredient for success in this relationship. Through considerate interaction Lleyton and Yvonne can develop a warm and loving relationship, whether this be a love union, work association, student and teacher connection or friendship. There is a childlike quality to

this liaison, possibly Lleyton and Yvonne share a love of children or enjoy recapturing some of their lost childhood. Through this relationship Lleyton learns a vital life lesson, one that furthers his spiritual journey. In some way Yvonne helps Lleyton to let go of intellectual insecurities, paving the way for a more wholesome approach to learning. It is possible that Lleyton is a student of Yvonne's. In return Yvonne realises new skills, in particular that of communicating information with compassion and empathy.

Yvonne's Mercury is Trine Lleyton's North Node (Orb 4°47')

The North Node is a significant point in relationship astrology, indicating fate in any association. In this case Yvonne and Lleyton are destined to meet and learn from each. Perhaps they meet in a study group, as pen pals or at a college. Lleyton gains insight and understanding through his association with Yvonne. Perhaps Yvonne is a teacher imparting specific knowledge, or maybe Yvonne's presence communicates certain messages that are valuable for Lleyton's life lessons. Either way Yvonne and Lleyton are comfortable interacting with each other. Depending on aspects of Yvonne and Lleyton's birth charts, this association indicates an intellectual rapport rather than a passionate or emotional bond.

Lleyton's Mercury is Opposite Yvonne's Pluto (Orb 2°37')

This is a potentially explosive combination of the planets Mercury and Pluto, with communication playing a key role. The problem is that this combination indicates a battle of two minds. Both Lleyton and Yvonne discover that they trigger forceful emotions and thoughts in each other. At times the intensity becomes overwhelming and they don't know what to do. It is vital that both Lleyton and Yvonne communicate honestly, keeping all emotions and thoughts out in the open as much as is possible. Otherwise their relationship is likely to become volcanic, possibly even abusive as they battle to make themselves understood. They both find it near impossible to simply let matters slide, feeling that they must tackle each other head on. This works well if both Lleyton and Yvonne are able to enjoy penetrating and honest discussions. However, if they don't then one of them, probably Lleyton, is likely to suffer. Positively this relationship is transformative. Negatively it is abusive. The nature of the union depends on Lleyton and Yvonne's personalities and other aspects of their association.

Lleyton's Venus is Conjunct Yvonne's Jupiter (Orb 5°07')

This is an ideal combination for a rewarding relationship, particularly a love union or close personal bond. Both Lleyton and Yvonne feel at ease in each other's company, sharing a common sense of adventure and joy. The old hit song "You Light Up My Life" could be a good theme song for this relationship. Together Lleyton and Yvonne enjoy good fortune, exploring the realms of higher learning, culture, religion or metaphysics. They may delight in traveling to foreign lands, meeting new people and discovering different ways of life. Alternatively they may take delight in joining a study group closer to home. Either way their horizons are expanded by this union and the attraction is strong. Lleyton is enchanted by Yvonne's wisdom, experiencing a sense of being led into new and exciting territory. He loves the way that Yvonne contributes a sense of joy and fulfillment to his life. In return Yvonne enjoys the fact that Lleyton is always willing to support her ventures.

Yvonne's Venus is Conjunct Lleyton's Uranus (Orb 5°04')

This combination of planets indicates an instant and vital magnetism. It is the type of attraction in which Yvonne and Lleyton take one look at each other across a crowded room and feel the sparks. Romance is alight and the relationship develops at a rapid rate. Friends are amazed as the couple's union becomes more and more intense. In the short term this relationship provides fun, excitement and stimulation for both Yvonne and Lleyton. The long-term scenario depends on other aspects of their relationship and the ability of both Yvonne and Lleyton to respect each other's need for autonomy. It is all too easy for the initial flame to burn out of control. For this reason this combination of planets can be more prominent in relationships that contain the intrigue of a love affair, rather than the stability of a long-term union. Yvonne feels particularly struck by Cupid's arrow, ignited by the very presence of Lleyton. She wants her love to be strong enough to keep the spark of excitement in the relationship. However, Lleyton is hard to pin down and is likely to become bored once the initial excitement starts to fade unless he is given plenty of room to be independent. It may be difficult for Lleyton to make a commitment to this relationship unless he is given the freedom to

inspire Yvonne without feeling tied down to promises. A strong bond can be achieved if Yvonne and Lleyton can find the right balance between intimacy and personal freedom. If this is achieved then they can both enjoy a long-term relationship full of joy and romance.

Lleyton's Venus is Trine Yvonne's Neptune (Orb 5°29')

Romance is the key theme of this combination of planets. Lleyton and Yvonne feel that they have met their one true love under the influence of the planets Venus and Neptune. They meet, fall in love and create a union brimming with romance, joy and idyllic love. Whether or not this idyll lasts depends on other aspects of the association. During the course of their union they are able to interact in a loving and creative manner. It's also possible that Lleyton and Yvonne participate in a joint creative and imaginative pursuit, inspiring each other to stretch their artistic talents. Perhaps Lleyton and Yvonne follow a spiritual path together. Lleyton is particularly attracted to Yvonne's artistic and altruistic nature. He appreciates all of the qualities that Yvonne brings to their relationship. In response Yvonne feels that Lleyton's support enables her talents to blossom. While this attraction is more likely to involve the love and devotion associated with a strong bond such as marriage, it can also depict a creative, artistic or spiritual working partnership.

Lleyton's Venus is Sextile Yvonne's Chiron (Orb 2°09')

Together Lleyton and Yvonne have opportunities to heal the painful experiences of previous relationships and forge a strong and loving bond. This is an important union. When an intimate bond is formed, the love can soothe emotional pain and bring a sense of freedom and joy. On the other hand it can also reinforce a person's wounds, sending them into emotional turmoil and forming negative relationship patterns. In this case Lleyton and Yvonne have a chance to overcome their old relating habits through their love for each other. They may even help each other view their childhood experiences in a different light. This is true whether they are lovers or friends. Lleyton's love is particularly soothing for Yvonne, encouraging her to discover new talents. In return Yvonne teaches Lleyton the benefits of a warm and loving relationship.

Yvonne's Venus is Trine Lleyton's North Node (Orb 5°29')

This is the combination for lovers. The North Node and Venus are both highly significant in relationship astrology indicating that this association was written in the stars. It is also likely that Yvonne and Lleyton are in love, desiring to form a close and romantic bond, rather than remain friends only. Passion, romantic love and an intense desire to relate are central to this relationship. Within moments of meeting Yvonne and Lleyton feel they have known each other for years. They enjoy each other's company, discovering pleasures in common. If circumstances dictate that their relationship can only be a friendship, they would be wise to tread very carefully. This is not an association to take lightly. It could easily take over Yvonne or Lleyton's lives. In some circumstances this combination of Venus and the North Node can indicate an association formed for artistic or creative projects.

Lleyton's Venus is Opposite Yvonne's Pluto (Orb 4°17')

This is a powerful combination of planets indicating a strong bond, whether in a friendship, love union or work association. Lleyton and Yvonne experience a compelling attraction to each other, one that easily becomes passionate and intense. Depending on the nature of the relationship, Lleyton and Yvonne could easily end up in bed together. Positively they are transformed by this relationship, becoming more influential and powerful in their own lives, even if initially they have to overcome moments of feeling powerless. However, they also experience intense emotional battles as the passionate nature of the union becomes difficult to control. If Lleyton and Yvonne are in a romantic liaison, these emotional struggles can overflow into the bedroom adversely affecting sexual relations. It is also possible that this combination of planets indicates a love affair that is intense and fraught with emotional problems. While both Lleyton and Yvonne experience the tension, Lleyton feels more overwhelmed. He may even feel bullied by the strong personality of Yvonne. Lleyton finds it difficult to live his life effectively while in this relationship. Yvonne struggles to understand Lleyton and becomes impatient, wanting him to be more assertive. Yvonne doesn't realise how domineering she appears to be. The challenge for both Lleyton and Yvonne is to direct their passion in a positive direction, possibly a shared artistic or creative pursuit.

Lleyton's Mars is Trine Yvonne's Uranus (Orb 4°18')

Sexual attraction plays a key role in this relationship. Lleyton and Yvonne find each other's company exciting and feel compelled to explore an intimate relationship. They are aroused both in and out of the bedroom. The initial stages of the relationship are particularly stimulating, and the union continues to flourish as long as Lleyton and Yvonne give each other the freedom to follow their individual interests. The electric nature of Lleyton and Yvonne's association is such that they need time away from each other in order to slow down and experiences some tranquility in their separate lives. This is not a peaceful or stable relationship but rather one that offers ongoing stimulation and change. For this reason the relationship may be short-lived, a thrilling adventure which soon loses its spark through a lack of commitment. However, other aspects of Lleyton and Yvonne's nature may provide the tenacity and steadiness needed for a long-term commitment. The challenge is to allow each other plenty of independence.

Yvonne's Mars is Trine Lleyton's Chiron (Orb 0°28')

A common goal is needed in order to make the best of this combination of the planet Mars and Chiron. If Yvonne and Lleyton share the same drive and ambition then they can successfully overcome past failures and progress in their lives together. Together they bring an element of play and laughter into areas of their lives that were previously weighed down with pain and angst. Together their activities take on a new glow. They may share an interest in the healing arts or in teaching. Lleyton sometimes feels hurt that Yvonne does not offer the energy and drive needed to support his ventures. As the relationship develops more support may be offered. Yvonne appreciates Lleyton's insights and wisdom, which enable her to better achieve her goals.

Lleyton's Jupiter is Conjunct Yvonne's Saturn (Orb 8°38')

A strong bond is formed as a result of this combination of the planets Jupiter and Saturn, in which both Lleyton and Yvonne learn a great deal from each other. In many ways Lleyton and Yvonne take an opposing approach to their relationship. Lleyton is more adventurous, keen to explore new territories. He takes a somewhat philosophical approach to this relationship. On the other hand Yvonne is cautious, often taking a slower and more practical outlook. Fortunately they enjoy these opposing qualities, finding equilibrium in their relationship. Yvonne finds her day enlivened by Lleyton's personality. In turn Lleyton enjoys having a stable and patient companion to bounce his ideas off. Yvonne learns much from Lleyton's wisdom, gaining a greater understanding of her own nature. Together Lleyton and Yvonne can achieve much success in either their personal lives or a joint project.

Yvonne's Jupiter is Trine Lleyton's Pluto (Orb 5°08')

Yvonne and Lleyton are rejuvenated through their relationship. Life takes on a new glow from their first moment of meeting. In each other Yvonne and Lleyton have found a soul-mate, someone who understands them at a very deep, metaphysical level. As the relationship develops both Yvonne and Lleyton are challenged to reach deep within themselves in order to change and grow. Depending on their individual traits they can either enjoy this process of change or they can resist. Either way they are being dared to view their lives in a different and broader manner. Yvonne and Lleyton encourage each other in this growth process through co-operation and understanding. Together they feel able to overcome all obstacles. As a result it is likely that, through this union, both Yvonne and Lleyton begin to lead more creative lives.

Yvonne's Jupiter is Square Lleyton's Uranus (Orb 0°48')

This combination of the two planets Jupiter and Uranus indicates a meeting of two individual minds. In some associations it can be a case of "opposites attract". At the beginning of their relationship Yvonne and Lleyton are attracted by the novelty of each other, but this quickly wears off. However, differences between Yvonne and Lleyton are difficult to overcome. What follows is a discordant union. Their individual natures clash. What was once attractive becomes irritating and a cause of friction. Both Yvonne and Lleyton find it awkward to allow each other the independence needed to pursue their individual interests. The end result for an intimate bond depends on other aspects of the relationship. However, this combination is a formidable one and could result in a love relationship breaking down unless Yvonne and Lleyton find a way of following their independent paths within their association. A friendship or work association also needs to

provide plenty of scope for individual expression.

Yvonne's Saturn is Sextile Lleyton's Ascendant (Orb 1°34')

The planet Saturn is a vital ingredient in relationship astrology. It is the planet that represents stability and commitment and is seen by astrologers as the necessary glue that holds a relationship together on a long-term basis. Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. This is particularly true of connections between one person's Saturn and another person's Sun, Moon, Ascendant or Nodes. In this case Yvonne's Saturn is combining with Lleyton's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant relationship. Yvonne and Lleyton feel strongly drawn to each other, perhaps experiencing a sense that their relationship was written in the stars. In other words they may feel as though they were destined to meet and form a union. This is a significant relationship.

Lleyton's Neptune is Trine Yvonne's Ascendant (Orb 1°36')

It is significant in relationship astrology when one person's planet makes contact with the Ascendant in another person's chart. In this case Lleyton's Neptune is combining with Yvonne's Ascendant indicating that this is a significant relationship. Lleyton and Yvonne feel strongly drawn to each other. Romance is in the air. Both Lleyton and Yvonne are in love and floating on air, as the saying goes. They enjoy the first throes of romantic love and have a knack for re-creating romance. It is possible that this relationship could falter under the demands of daily practicalities. This combination can indicate an association based on mutual spiritual, artistic or philanthropic interests, but it is most likely in a romantic union.

Generational Values



Underpinning the success of many relationships is a sense of shared values. Often this comes from simply being born into the same generation. However, sometimes it is more complex. In this section we explore whether or not Yvonne and Lleyton share the same societal values.

Yvonne's Saturn is Conjunct Lleyton's Saturn (Orb 8°18')

The role of the planet Saturn is important in relationships, particularly partnerships that require a long-term commitment. Both Yvonne and Lleyton's ability to work through difficulties in a positive and compassionate manner play an important part in this combination. This serious planet can represent either stability that enhances individual's lives, or restrictions and constraint that eventually erodes confidence. It can indicate a sharing or conflict of values. In this case it is likely that Yvonne and Lleyton share common values and enjoy a committed relationship that embraces the positive traits of fellowship and co-operation. There is an instant rapport and both Yvonne and Lleyton take this union seriously, respecting each other enough to continue to work through any difficult moments. They may also have a sense that they have waited a long time to achieve such a committed relationship. In other words they have both been through tough times in the past, but have found the right relationship now. This combination is an important

component of personal relationships because it indicates the commitment needed in a long-term union. It also indicates a sharing of life experiences that assist in mutual understanding. In some cases this combination may simply indicate that Yvonne and Lleyton are a similar age. Nevertheless the effect is still one that cements their relationship.

Yvonne's Saturn is Sextile Lleyton's Uranus (Orb 0°18')

The planet Saturn is a vital ingredient in relationship astrology. It is the planet that represents stability and commitment and is seen by astrologers as the necessary glue that holds a relationship together on a long-term basis. Of course not everyone is seeking long-term commitment, but for those who are Saturn is a welcome sign. In this case Yvonne and Lleyton are approaching their union from different angles and this can be both beneficial and detrimental. On the one hand Yvonne and Lleyton feel drawn to each other, recognising that they each have different traits to bring to this union. Yvonne is probably the more serious of the pair, providing stability and commitment, whereas Lleyton is more likely to provide the impetus for growth and change. If Yvonne becomes too stuck in her ways then Lleyton is able to spark a change of attitude. Together they strike a happy balance between responsibility and diversity.

Lleyton's Saturn is Square Yvonne's Uranus (Orb 0°07')

This is a difficult combination of planets in relationship astrology indicating an imbalance between commitment and freedom. On the one hand Lleyton and Yvonne feel drawn to each other, seeing qualities in each other that they feel they lack themselves. Lleyton and Yvonne believe that they will learn from being together. On the other hand; however, tension soon results as they fail to reconcile their differences. Lleyton is likely to take a more serious approach to this union, feeling the need for a strong bond. However, Yvonne is hard to pin down, preferring the freedom of non-commitment. Yvonne wants to initiate change and growth even though Lleyton is likely to resist. It is possible that Lleyton becomes frustrated and tries to control Yvonne's behaviour. Lleyton may even resort to criticism which ultimately only undermines Yvonne's creative impulses and self-confidence. If this happens Yvonne is likely to rebel and leave the relationship. Both Lleyton and Yvonne need to strive for a balance between commitment to each other and independence.

Yvonne's Neptune is Conjunct Lleyton's Pluto (Orb 5°28')

This planetary combination of Neptune and Pluto indicates common values, which can help form a basis for a relationship. However, many other combinations of planets will make a more significant contribution to this union between Yvonne and Lleyton. All relationships benefit from a sharing of values, however this combination is not highly significant.

Lleyton's Neptune is Conjunct Yvonne's Chiron (Orb 2°35')

The healing powers of nature, music and the arts may play a significant role in this union. Lleyton and Yvonne have a romantic and empathetic relationship, in which they both place importance on gentle and loving communication. As a result they are able to forgive and forget loved ones who have hurt them in the past, and move slowly towards a better understanding of their innermost selves and each other. The artistic and spiritual side of Lleyton's nature proves particularly healing for Yvonne. Under Lleyton's gentle influence, Yvonne is able to heal past emotional wounds and better express herself. Together they may take part in a spiritual, healing or artistic project.

Lleyton's Pluto is Sextile Yvonne's Chiron (Orb 2°07')

Personal growth is one theme in this relationship. Both Lleyton and Yvonne embrace change. Together they are willing to live life to the fullest, breaking free of habits or anything that hinders their progress in life. Lleyton and Yvonne may be at the centre of organisations involved with spiritual matters, personal growth, medicine and medical breakthroughs. There may be a strong sense of destiny attached to this union. Lleyton provides the impetus for change, preferring to challenge Yvonne's previously held beliefs and patterns of behaviour. In turn Yvonne is able to respond to Lleyton in a way that enables him to achieve his goals. This is a rewarding relationship as long as each person enjoys stimulation and transformation.

Yvonne's Pluto is Square Lleyton's Chiron (Orb 5°56')

Personal growth is one theme in this relationship, but the path to greater understanding is not smooth. Both Yvonne and Lleyton have difficulty coping with the intensity of this relationship, which challenges them at a deeply personal level. Memories of emotionally painful moments in previous relationships are brought to the surface and need to be resolved so that this relationship can succeed. At times Yvonne and Lleyton fear the demands of this union may be too much. The challenge is for them both to forgive and forget the past and embrace the present and the future. They need to be willing to live life to the fullest, breaking free of habits or anything that hinders their progress in life. There may be a strong sense of destiny attached to this union, and Yvonne and Lleyton may be at the centre of organisations involved with spiritual matters, personal growth, medicine and medical breakthroughs.
